Neurology- 411: Neurology is a course that deals with the study of diseases of brain and nervous system.

Neurological physical therapy-417: Neurological physical therapy is a course designed based on a structured, comprehensive approach to examine and treat adults with neurologic dysfunction.

PT for selected conditions-424: is a course that deals with the study of an integrated approach to theory and practice of physical therapy in the burns, gynecology, geriatric and cancer. Other selected studies may also be included.
Special Topics in Rehabilitation-425: is a course that deals with study of different approaches of rehabilitation that assist individuals who experience, or are likely to experience, disability to achieve and maintain optimal functioning in interaction with their environments
