## TEACHING EXPERIENCE

### Undergraduate physiotherapy – University of Dammam:

- **Biomechanics** (2 CR) 1<sup>st</sup> semester 2009 – 2011  
This course provides the study and application of biomechanical principles of motion to human movement. Basic biomechanics of musculoskeletal system and analysis of normal posture and gait will also be discussed.
- **Research Methodology** (2 CR) 1<sup>st</sup> semester 2012 – present  
This course aims to prepare student to submit a research proposal and to critically evaluate a scientific paper in physiotherapy. It provides basic concepts of research and its methodologies, helps students formulate researchable questions and understand and describe different study designs.
- **Musculoskeletal Physical Therapy II** (3 CR) 2<sup>nd</sup> semester 2009 – present  
This course is continuation for MSPT 316 (Musculoskeletal PT I). Physical therapy of diseases, injuries, and surgical of the musculoskeletal system affecting the spine will be emphasized. This course also describes spinal traction, and introduction to spinal mobilization.
- **Clinical Practice II** (3 CR) 2<sup>nd</sup> semester 2009 – present  
This course is a field experience in which students practice managing patients with diseases, injuries, and surgical of the musculoskeletal system affecting the spine as well as other conditions.

This program is a 2-year program.
