#### 1 Principles of Microeconomics ECON110

This course is designed to provide students with basic knowledge of the principles of economics which include the definition of economics, economic problem, the production possibilities curve, demand & supply and market equilibrium, the elasticities of demand and supply, consumer and producer equilibrium, production costs, the various forms of markets and conditions and the producer's equilibrium in these markets, and the demand for factors of production.



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2	<b>Principles of Macroeconomics ECON220</b> This course introduces concepts and theories in the field of macroeconomics. It develops student's ability to
	understand and estimate GDP and other national accounts. It also helps students in understanding the concept of macro equilibrium, economic cycles, unemployment, inflation, and economic policies (both
	monetary and fiscal policies).
3	Banking and Islamic Finance FIN363
