Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

The Prophet’s Biography: The course starts with life in Arabia before the time of the Prophet (Peace be upon him), and then cover the Prophet Muhammad’s early life, call to prophet-hood, Meccan opposition, challenges encountered by Muslims and the manners with which the Prophet (Peace be upon him) responded to them, emigration to Medina, The foundation of the state, and the spread of Islam in Arabia, the Farewell Pilgrimage and the prophet’s death.

The Rightly Guided Caliphs: The course examines the institution of the caliphate and its development. The expansion of Islam and its impact, administrative and financial organization. The Fitna and the end of the Rightly Guided caliphate

The Umayyads: This course deals with establishment of the Umayyad State. It concentrated on the political, Conquests , administrative and other developments in the Arab- Islamic society during which the Umayyad dynasty rule and the causes of the fall of the Umayyads.



Movement of orientalism: This course deals with the definition of Orientalism, its concept, emergence, history, motives, goals, fields, means, figures, writings, attitudes and methodologies. Then course focuses on orientalism and the Prophet Biography, the Caliphs, the Umayyads, Abbasids and orientalism as well as orientalism and Islamic civilization.

Islamic Civilization: The course deals with a comprehensive survey of the Islamic civilization. It starts with Islam and Science, an overview of the history of science in the Muslim societies, centers of knowledge and scientific development. Then it deals with the achievements of Muslim scholars in the fields of chemistry, physics, mathematics, astronomy, geography architecture as well as channels of the Islamic civilization to the Europe.

Historical Texts in English: The course includes historical texts in English from different sources. The course deals with the importance of a historical text and students will be trained to read , translate, understand and identify key points in the text.

Introduction to History: The course deals with the definition of history, the importance of the study of History. philosophy of history, important schools of history and historians, with special emphasis on Muslim historians and Muslim historiography
