Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

Nutritional Status Assessment (NUTR 211):

This course will provide a comprehensive overview on methods and approaches of nutritional status assessment in individuals and community on the clinical and research-based settings. The nutrition assessment is structured into five domains of the nutrition care process (NCP): first anthropometric measurements, second nutrition-focused physical findings, third biochemical data, medical tests, and procedures, fourth food/nutrition related history, and fifth client history. Nutrition assessment data and findings are compared with references and standards to establish an appropriate NCP foundation. Moreover, students will utilize critical thinking skills in their assessment.

Medical Nutrition Therapy 1 (NUTR 302):

This course is designed to introduce the students to acquire the necessary skills to work with the health care team as a successful dietitian. Students will know how to obtain the

information from the medical record, analyze it, and how to write a nutritional report. Students will apply their training in the hospital at the nutritional department and at different clinical units like medical, diabetes, cardio, renal, pancreas, and liver and gallbladder.

Nutritional Epidemiology (EPID 305):

This course presents the foundation of epidemiological concepts and how to apply them during the conduct of epidemiological nutritional research. The course covers the major subjects of nutritional epidemiology through scientific articles. By bridging research and evidence-based practices, the course equips students to become competent dietitians capable of promoting optimal nutrition for disease prevention and improving population health.

Enteral and Parenteral Nutrition (NUTR 308):

This course establishes the rationale and the criteria for appropriate nutrition support. It will focus on enteral and parenteral nutrition, formula composition, medication administration, monitoring and complications. Also, it will discuss nutritional support in home setting.

Nutritional Pharmacology (PHARM 401):

Basic knowledge on pharmacotherapy, nutrient drug interaction will prepare dietitians for clinical practice in the hospital.

Medical Nutrition Therapy Application 1 (NUTR 412):

- This course provides the students with required skills to work with the health care team as a qualified dietitian. Students will learn how to apply all steps of NCP in hospitals.
