#### Brief Description of Undergraduate Courses Taught: (Course Title – Code: Description)

1	Translation explores different features and forms of media translation and translation issues that enable the students to transfer the meaning of different text types from English into Arabic and vice versa accurately and naturally. Moreover, it attempts to employ the method and strategies of translation studies before on practical basis.
2	Writing1 is the first course that deals with writing skills. It focuses on teaching students the skills of writing paragraphs. It covers different genres of writing paragraphs such as descriptive and informative paragraphs.



	The last part includes writing a well-organized formal letter.
3	Grammar 1 involves all the various aspects that make up the rules of language. It names the types of words and word groups that make up the sentences and phrases of a given language. By the end of this course, the students should be able to form and recognize well-built sentences using a variety of grammatical rules.
4	Grammar 2 is designed to provide a review of both essential and finer points of the grammatical structural features of formal written English.
5	Creative Translation is a practical course which focuses on translating creative texts. This includes translating examples from Arabic and English rhetorical texts gradually such as; autobiography, speech, short story, novel, drama, poetry.
6	Introduction to Translation: Containing both theoretical and practical dimensions, The aim of this course is to introduce students to translation problems in General.
7	Reading 2 provides students with stimulating topics for discussion and a greater development of reading strategies, critical thinking skills and interactive tasks which students need to successfully comprehend and analyze, along with improving speed reading and promote fluency.
