

Institutional- Terms of Reference ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE

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The Resident Assessment Committee (RAC) is a subcommittee of *the Programs Administration Committee* and its duty is to provide advice on residents assessment and on continuing professional development.

Composition of the Assessment Committee (AC)

- 1. The Chair of the RAC shall be appointed from its membership and serve a 2-year term (renewable)
- 2. Program Directors (2-3)
- 3. *Teaching faculty (Should have the knowledge and skills of Royal college Standards for assessment, clinical teaching & work based assessment)
- 4. One faculty with expertise in professional development and One faculty with expertise in work based assessment
- 5. One faculty with expertise in in-practice assessment
- 6. Two residents one annually appointed by the PAC and one elected by other residents

Meetings

- The committee will hold a meeting twice a year or as requested by the chairman of the committee
- First week of January and May of each academic year, site: Faculty Meeting Room at KFHU, Alkhobar

Documentation

- Agenda & any relevant documentation will be pre-circulated to RAC members, prior to each meeting at least one month before the scheduled meeting
- Minutes of the meeting will be taken by a committee member appointed by the committee and the signed original will be kept by the office of Vice Dean for Higher Studies & Scientific Research
- Minutes will be distributed to all committee members

^{*}At least one representative from Internal Medicine, Surgery, Pediatrics, and Obs & Gyn must be included and each of these members shall serve a term of 2 years (renewable).

Accountability

• The committee will report to the *Programs Administration Committee*.

Purpose

- 1. Develop policies and standards required for resident's assessment.
- 2. Provide insight on assessment policy and procedure.
- 3. Give advice to the Chairman of *Programs Administration Committee*, on matters related to accreditation and quality of education
- 4. Oversee and approve the development of policy for credentials, examinations, workplace based assessment, and routes to certification, in tandem with its subcommittees as relevant; and
- 5. Oversee an appeal mechanism for decisions made by any of its subcommittees.
- 6. RAC has three subcommittees, Examination Committee, Committee on Work-Based assessment and the Credential Committee.

Decision Taking

Quorum consists of a majority of the voting members of the committee (i.e., 50% plus one) and decision is carried by majority voting.
