CARE AT HOME AFTER HERNIORRHAPHY, HYDROCELECTOMY, ORCHIDOPEXY

ACTIVITIES:

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Quiet activities today with close supervision.

| After 24 hours: | |
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| Under 4 years old: | no restriction but close supervision. |
| 4-10 years old: | no bicycle, gym or sports for 2 weeks. |
| Over 10 years old: | no bicycle, gym or sports for 4-6 weeks. |
| | no competitive sports for 2 months. |

SCHOOL: May go back to school after 3-5 days.

BATH: Sponge bath for the first 48 hours, then begin tub baths.

DRESSING:

Remove the dressing at home as instructed by the surgeon (usually 2-3 days after the surgery). No special wound care. Keep the area dry and clean.

MEDICATION:

For pain, give Acetaminophen (Tylenol or Tempra) every 6-8 hours if needed.

DIET:

Give water, apple juice or Jell-O for one to two hours. If tolerated, Proceed with a soft diet such as soup and yogurt. Tomorrow, he may be given a normal diet.



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
