

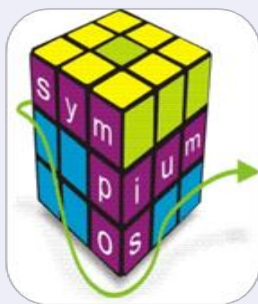

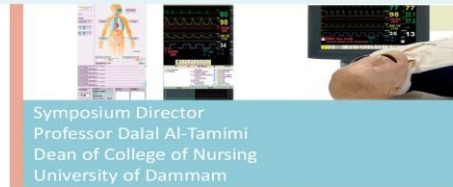
You are cordially invited to participate in our forthcoming symposium and workshop at the University of Dammam, College of Nursing
