Ultrasound Examination of Blood Vessels



Vascular Doppler is a non-invasive examination through which blood flow can be measured and monitored and the causes that hinder the function of the vessels are detected. It includes examination of vessels of the limbs, neck, abdomen, pelvis, and brain (infants and newborns)

Irregular heartbeat




Weakness of the vein valves in the feet and peripheral vascular disease (varicose)



Low temperature in one of the limbs, which limits blood flow to it



Aneurysm and evaluation of the mode of blood flow



An open wound in the area of the examination

Before

It is always recommended to wear comfortable clothes, so that detection of the area to be examined is easy and fast.

During

The specialist will ask you to reveal the area to be examined with some instructions to change the position of standing, sitting or lying down, or the method of breathing for the abdominal vessels (during the examination)

After

Refer to the attending physician to discuss the results of the examination and find appropriate solutions for you
