

Post-retinal Surgery Instructions

- 1 Adhere to the sleeping and sitting position.
- 2 Avoid rubbing or applying pressure to your eyes.
- **3** Adhere to the medication prescribed.
- 4) You can watch TV, and use smart devices.
- You can perform wudu (ablution) and take a shower from the second day of surgery but avoid getting water in your eye.
- **6** Avoid bowing and prostration.
- **7** Avoid driving until vision improved.
- Avoid air travel or going to high places when injecting your eye with gas.
- Use an protective eye cover especially when you sleep, until the first post-operative appointment.
- When the following symptoms appear you should go to emergency:

 Sudden decrease in every vision
 - Sudden decrease in eye vision.
 - Sever pain and redness in the eye.
