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Introduction:

The student orientation program are mandatory for all newly admitted students to actively engage in the college facilities and activities. These orientations will introduce the students to the rich academic, social, and cultural life of the university. It will also inspire and enhance their attitude and enthusiasm about their education and make them feel welcome.



Preparatory Year Orientation for Health Track students:

The Deanship of the Preparatory Year and Supporting Studies organizes meetings between students and various university officials, including academics and administrators. These meetings include three main axes. The first axis includes meetings to familiarize students with the university rules and regulations, the study system, the e-services, learning resources, academic supervision, course registration, the quality system, and students' activities at the Deanship. The second axis includes meetings to introduce students to the university's admission and registration mechanisms, student activities and clubs, university accommodation, as well as security and safety procedures. The third axis highlights the different colleges' meetings with their respective deans and academic affairs representatives. They are intended to present the various disciplines at the college, the different programs for those majors, the nature of the study, and the future job opportunities for its graduate



End of Preparatory Year Orientation for Health Track students :

The Deanship of the Preparatory Year of Study & Supportive Studies , Deanship of Student Affairs and College of Dentistry organizes an orientation session for Preparatory year health track students at the end of the academic year. The VDAA represents the dental college by orienting the students about the major educational and scientific facilities along with the college policies and admission process, college's history, accreditations, values, vision, and mission. At the end of this session, students are oriented with the requirements needed to graduate and future Job opportunities in the dentistry field.



Pre-Dental COD Admission Orientation:

The orientation is conducted by the COD admission committee in collaboration with the Deanship of Admission and Registration for potential applicants before the date of interviews and manual dexterity test.

This orientation helps students understand the nature of the college and the educational opportunities available to them. It also introduces them to academic and nonacademic activities, support services, future Job opportunities and postgraduate programs. The frequently asked questions about the college and admission will be addressed at the end of orientation.



New Dental Students Orientation:

For the newly enrolled dental students (2nd-year students), a comprehensive orientation session is arranged by the VDAA at the commencement of every academic year. The main goal of the program orientation is to inspire and enhance the attitude and enthusiasm of the newly enrolled students about their education, and to make the new students feel welcomed, appreciated, and supported. The orientation session is a good opportunity for the new students to meet the teaching staff as well as socializing with senior students and prepare for managing their schedules, timetables, course materials and textbooks. The dean, vice deans, department chairpersons, registrar and students' support service administrators participate in the orientation sessions and all faculty members are encouraged to attend.



Course Orientation:

Course orientations provided to students through an introductory session during the first lecture or session of the course by the course director. Also, by course specifications prepared by the course director and provided the registered students at the beginning of every semester with course specifications (printed and on blackboard). The specifications will include details about the course content, teaching and assessment methods, and essential textbooks.



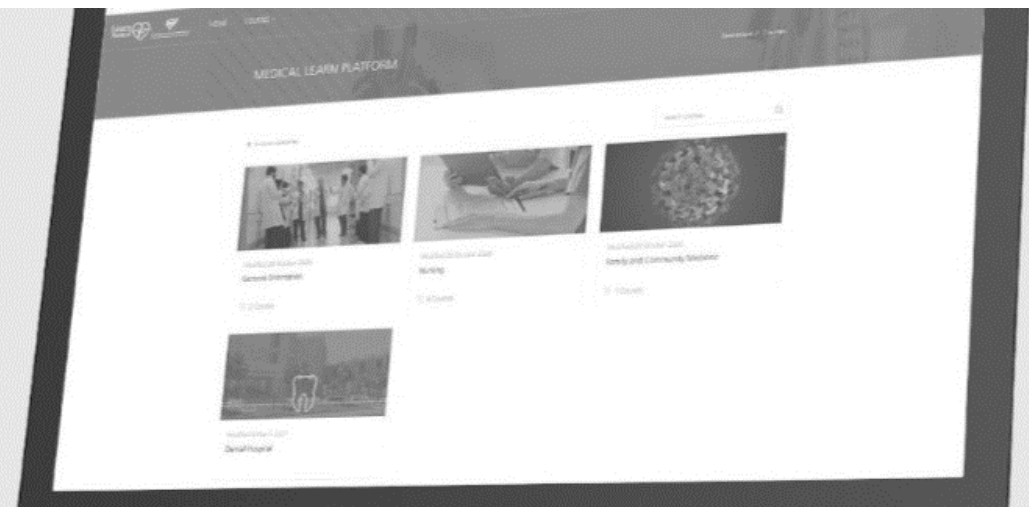
University Dental Hospital Student Orientation:
